The Beckwith Top 10

1. We hope remote learning is progressing more smoothly for everyone with each day. Students are expected to check into homeroom at 8 a.m. Their day will end at 2:15 p.m. We are including a link to the Beckwith [FAQs](#). If you need assistance, as always, feel free to contact the Beckwith office at 508-252-5080 or email a staff member.

2. Wednesdays are **Tech Light Days**. On Wednesdays our students will attend their remote classes from 8:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. Each class will be approximately 40 minutes long, with no study block. When they return from lunch, students are expected to complete specific work assigned by their teacher earlier in the day. The breakdown of class times is attached to today's email and is also on the Beckwith calendar. Please note that the order of the students' classes will not change just the time they meet. We have attached an updated form for you.

3. Beckwith will host a Meet Your Teacher event on September 24 (for grades 7 and 8). This will give students the opportunity to briefly meet their teachers and to pick up their agendas and gather their books and materials for their classes. Your child might want to bring a backpack to carry the materials home. We ask that only 1 parent or guardian attend with the child. And, as always, please observe social distance protocols.

5. The Grab and Go lunch service is now available. Pick up will again be at DRRHS from 10 am to noon and all are welcome to participate. This service is free for all Dighton-Rehoboth students. For students in high needs programs, both breakfast and lunch will be provided for free.

6. From the Health Room: All 7th grade student immunizations and current physical information must be up to date and provided to the health office. If you have not provided this information to Mrs. Mondor, our school nurse, it must be submitted at this time. All students must have a current (less than one year old) physical on file in order to try out for any sport. New requirements for students this year is that grade 7 students must have TDAP and meningitis vaccine MCV4. All students are required to have the flu

shot before December 31, 2020. Paperwork can be emailed to Mrs. Mondor at cmondor@drregional.org

7. If your child will not be attending remote classes on a particular day, that morning please leave a message on our absence line 508-252-5080. If your child has an excused absence, please ask your child's doctor to fax the medical excuse to us at 508-252-5082.

9. Please be sure to check the parent portal periodically for your child's most current academic status. Report cards can be viewed and printed through the parent portal once term grades have been posted.

10. Parents who are picking up their child from school should email svincelette@drregional.org and krebello@drregional.org on the day they are picking up their child stating that the child is being picked up, the time of pick-up, and who is picking up the child. We will be checking the sender's email against what we have listed in X2 for verification. We will still require the person picking up to present your driver's license as identification so that we can release the child. Please do not fax the requests since we will not be able to verify who is sending the fax.
