School Supply List

For use in all classes, students need a pencil case or zippered pouch that contains:

- pencils (many, many pencils)
- erasers
- a silent pencil sharpener
- 1 set of colored pencils, held together with a rubber band
- 1 green, 1 yellow, and 1 pink highlighter
- glue sticks (at least 2)
- a pair of scissors
- a small personal whiteboard
- expo markers
- 3-5 face coverings (in order to rotate/clean each day)
- Small bottle of hand sanitizer
- Headphones or earbuds
- Recommended: computer mouse

Students will also need the following items by subject:

Math (Mrs. Grosslein & Mrs. Zalk)

- 1-inch or 1 ¼-inch binder
- 1 package of dividers
- 1 package of loose leaf paper
- 1 two-pocket folder for math work only
- a computer mouse
- a calculator (scientific preferred)
- 1 box of Kleenex (please)

English Language Arts (Mr. Hamilton & Mrs. Bilentschuk)

- an independent reading book at your “just right” reading level
- 1 two-pocket folder
- Pack of Post-it notes

Science (Mrs. Sousa & Mr. Camillo)

- 2 packs of index cards
- 1 two-pocket folder
- 1 spiral notebook
- 1 composition book
- one box of Kleenex, and one roll of paper towels
- 1 book cover (paper bags work, too)

Social Studies (Mrs. DeMelo & Mr. Brideau)

- one 1 or 1 ¼-inch binder with a view-cover
- 1 pack of 5-Tab dividers
- 1 pack of loose leaf paper
- page reinforcers
- 1 book cover (one may be reused throughout the year, and paper-bag covers are acceptable)

Optional organization strategy: We strongly suggest color-coding school supplies. For example, the notebook, folder, and binder for math should be all one solid color. Then the folder for ELA should be another color.

If any students are unable to obtain these items over the summer, they should let their teacher know at the beginning of the school year.
